## **PURPOSE:**

The purposes of this report is to inform the State Board of Education of the activities and programs conducted during the 2011-2012 school year by the Maryland Association of Student Councils (MASC) and to introduce the new President of MASC for 2012-2013.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Since 1971, the Maryland State Department of Education has sponsored the Maryland Association of Student Councils (MASC). Today, MASC is comprised of member schools from 21 regions across the state. MASC has a proud history of supporting and organizing civic engagement through lobbying and supporting a state charity each year.
