**PURPOSE:**

To provide information on action taken by the Board of Public Works (BPW) related to the FY 2009 budget.

**BACKGROUND/HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:**

The State's economic situation requires further cost containment action for the current fiscal year. This is the third action taken by BPW to reduce the FY 2009 budget. Prior actions were in June 2008 and October 2008.

The attached schedule reflects the items adjusted from the Maryland State Department of Education budget. The reductions total \$1,392,107 and include six vacant positions and one part-time contractual position. All reductions in this action are from the Headquarters budget. Along with specific reductions noted on the schedule, this also recognizes the savings from the Statewide furlough plan. These adjustments will be incorporated in a later budget document, depending on when they are officially posted in the State's accounting system.
